# Information

---

Sirocco Golf Club provides junior golfers (ages 5-18) the chance to enjoy and learn the game of golf through an affordable and accessible junior program.

The Sirocco Golf Club offers both chartered and sponsored junior memberships. Chartered juniors are the children or grandchildren of our charter members. Sponsored junior memberships are available to the general public. Juniors are encouraged to utilize the practice facility and golf course as much as possible.

Included in the membership is the following:

- Unlimited golf with 7 day advance booking. Anytime Monday through Thursday and any time after 2pm on Fridays, Weekends and holidays.
  - First Access to Operation 36 Classes
- Chartered juniors can play anytime but must be accompanied by their member parent in the restricted times.
  - Unlimited range and practice facility access

# Code of Conduct

---

Our Junior members are expected to conduct themselves in a professional and respectful manner at all times while at the facility. Our juniors are also expected to behave this way while representing the club at other golf courses whether playing for team Sirocco at interclub events, other tournaments or just a casual round of golf. Sirocco Golf Club will not tolerate inappropriate behavior including:

- Interfering with the learning environment of other players  
Harassment of any kind including abuse, fighting, threats and other inappropriate behavior
- There will be ZERO tolerance towards any forms of bullying
- Any behavioral issues will be brought to the attention of the parent immediately. If behavioral issues persist, Sirocco reserves the right to remove the junior from membership with written notice. A dues refund will not be issued.
- Power Carts are not to be driven by any junior members
- Juniors must adhere to basic golf course etiquette including; Pace of Play - juniors are required to understand time pars and follow them.
- Course care - It is critical that all members replace divots, rake bunkers and repair ball marks.
- If juniors are joined with another group or are playing on their own they are to act respectfully and with accordance to the Sirocco Code of Conduct.
- Juniors 12 and over can play unaccompanied on the golf course and practice facility. Juniors between the ages of 10 and 12, must pass a knowledge and etiquette test. Juniors under 10 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

# Code of Conduct

---

- Please show up 15 minutes prior to your tee time and check in with the pro shop
- Dress Code - Sirocco Junior Members are to adhere to the dress enforced at the club:
- Proper golf shoes (soft spikes) or runners are required.
- Jeans are not permitted on the course, driving range or putting greens.
- Shirts for men must have a collar. Women's tops may have a collar with no sleeves or no collar with sleeves. All shorts must have an inseam of no less than six inches with a finished hem.

## Pace of Play

Junior members are to adhere to the pace of play policies instituted at the club

\* 5th Tee 1 Hour

\* Finish 9 Holes 2 Hours and 5 Minutes

\* 14th Tee 3 Hours and 5 Minutes

\* Finish 18 Holes 4 Hours and 15 Minutes

# Operation 36

We want to give our golfers the best introduction and long-term development plan to become a skilled golfer. Operation 36 is the fastest growing golfer development model and coaching program delivered around the world. The program gives our staff a way to organize a golfer's development and measure improvement over time. The end goal is to get all of our golfers to shoot (par) 36 from a full tee-box!

## How the program works:

Each golfer in our programs will get a profile in our community in the Operation 36 App. We will be offering 9 Hole Operation 36 formatted events with our existing coaching programs for juniors and adults. After each event, our staff will record the scores on your profile and track your progress over time. The app also allows our staff to organize programs & schedules digitally to improve communication with our families.

## Benefits to our membership:

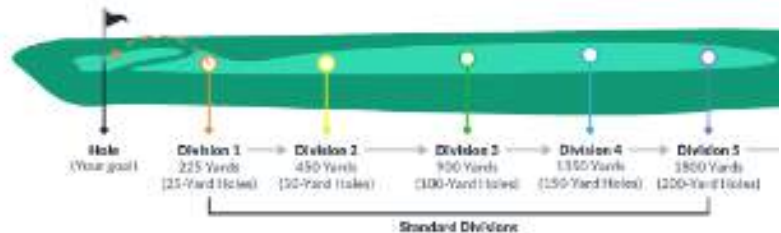
For our juniors, it allows us to track their golf development over-time and gives parents a timely and motivating way to get their junior on the golf course. Our coaches have access to a junior development model that can help us project where a junior's handicap will be by the time they graduate high school. Parents can quickly switch between juniors in the mobile app to see their goals & log when they play and train. Each session is shared with coaches to help guide and report on their golf development each year.

For our adults, it is a fun way to improve your golf game and gives us a tool to communicate and help set goals. If you are a complete beginner it gives you the best path to become a golfer. If you have already played, it is a fun social challenge to see where you can shoot 36 (par) for 9 holes from. With the use of the technology, our staff can help you measurably improve by setting video goals, issuing you practice plans and more.

## OPERATION 36® GOLF

### How the on-course model works:

- 1 Play 9 Holes From Division 1 (25 Yards)**  
Instead of starting at the full tee box, all golfers begin in Division 1 and will play 9 holes starting 25 yards from each green.
- 2 Shoot par (36) or better to pass Division**  
If they shoot par (36) or better, the golfer progresses to Division 2, where they start 50 yards from each green.
- 3 Complete the Division 10 challenge**  
This challenge continues until the golfer can shoot par (36) from all 10 divisions!

# Junior Night

---

Junior Nights will begin on May 2. Juniors of all ages and skill levels are encouraged to attend. Each scheduled event will consist of two, separate sessions available to all Sirocco junior members with our certified PGA of Canada Professionals. These sessions are free for all junior members. The first session will begin at 4 PM and will be for juniors between the ages of 5-8. This session will be 45 minutes in length and will help the younger golfers learn key golf movements. The second session will begin at 5 PM and is for the older golfers ages 9 +. This clinic 'supervised practice' session will allow the juniors to be out on the range with Golf Professionals close by giving a helping hand. Here your child will learn how and what to practice as well as how to prepare themselves to play on the golf course. Additionally, tee times will be blocked off for this group starting at 6:00 so they can go play after. Juniors under the age of 9 have an option to play 5 or 9 holes and require one parent volunteer to assist with each group. Parents are asked to help monitor safety & etiquette (repairing divots, ball marks, raking bunkers, directing & keeping score). Information will be provided to the parent volunteer to help them understand and regulate expectations. Below is a list of scheduled sessions:

## Junior Group Lessons Ages 5-14

Within this age bracket, Juniors of all skill levels are welcomed as our PGA of Canada instructors have designed a series of lessons that will focus on participation and teach the fundamentals of golf in a fun and active environment. Proven concepts from the CN Future Links Learn to Play Program, Operation 36 and the US Kids Golf Program are integrated into these lesson designs creating our very own Sirocco recipe for junior golf development.

Series 1 will take place every Saturday for 3 weeks from May 14 to May 28 (June 4 is a scheduled make up date if lessons are cancelled due to weather). Series 2 will take place from June 11 to June 25. (July 2 will act as the scheduled make up date for this series)
